## For the first 24 years of my life I tried many things to find some purpose in life, all of them left me wanting.

I grew up in a very loving family but church was not very important to me. I remember graduating from high school with a desire to have a large impact on the world. I had decided to do it by becoming a research chemist and making some noteworthy discovery. I went to the University of Minnesota but left after a year. I remember deciding that I either needed to change my objective in life or admit failure.

The first was much easier than the second so I decided that I would become friends with as many people as possible. That way, at the end of my life, I would be able to look back and see that I influenced many during my life. Over time I realized that I was being selfish in my choice of friends, not near as noble as I thought. Again, I had to admit failure or change my objective in life.
